



Dear St. John's Families,

Hello! We hope this letter finds you well and enjoying the beautiful summer that we've been having. With Fall just around the corner, we wanted to let you know that we've been thinking about your family and we are hoping to see everyone in person soon!

As children's ministry leaders, we find ourselves searching for new ways to stay connected to our youngest members and their families while adhering to safety procedures mandated by the Department of Health. At this time, we have developed a plan for Sunday School. Sunday School would be conducted each Sunday in a whole group setting in the meeting area downstairs for students K-5 and students in grades 6-8 would meet separately. **Sunday School would begin on September 27th** and run from 10 a.m. – 11 a.m as usual. During this time, the kids will participate in a whole group faith building lesson that is fun and age appropriate for all! The following procedures would be in place:

Families would be asked to arrive 15 – 20 minutes early to allow for screening.

All entry will be only through the Front Glass Doors – Side parking lot doors are not available

Face Masking, Temperature Scan and Hand Sanitizing will be expected for everyone.

Safety precautions will need to be practiced throughout the Sunday School hour, therefore students would be wearing their masks and placed 6 ft. apart at tables in their meeting rooms.

When Sunday School is over, we will ask that only one parent/guardian comes to the meeting room to pick up their child/children and parents should remain at a safe distance while waiting.

In order to plan for a successful Sunday School program, we need all families who plan on attending Sunday School, to please fill out the attached Sunday School Registration Form and return it to St. John's **by Sunday, September 13th**. You can drop this form off at church during worship time over the next few weeks, mail the form back to church or you can go to the church website and follow the directions to fill out the form.

Although things may look differently, there will be many new and exciting things happening in Sunday School this year. We are looking forward to seeing everyone and continuing to build the faith of our youngest St. John's members. We will continue to monitor and adhere to all safety procedures set by the DOH.
