Dear Confirmation Students and Parents,

Attached please find the 2023-2024 Confirmation Schedule. We will meet on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month (with exception to Sundays that conflict with a holiday). Sessions will begin at 10:00am beginning September 10th.

Students are expected to attend every session in order to be Confirmed. If a session is missed due to illness, family vacation, or family emergency I will make every effort to accommodate a make up session. However, sessions missed for sports events or other related /non-essential activities will not be excused. These missed sessions can be made up the next time the session returns in the confirmation cycle (please note: this is a 3yr cycle. The appointed lessons for this year will not return for some time). I will hold to this firmly. Please understand, it wouldn't be right of me to compromise the program. Furthermore, as I see it, to make exception is to put other "stuff" before God. I cant in good conscience do that. Please understand, I get it! Having four kids of my own I completely understand the pressure and the demands of life, school, sports, and recreation. Having said that though, I also understand the huge difference regular connection to God and Christian community has on ones life.

I have tried numerous things over the last few years to accommodate the scheduling demands. A Sunday morning schedule is the result of continual conflicts experienced during weekdays. I certainly hope that this will work for you! Faith is a crucial part of our lives and it will be truly heartbreaking to me if students cant find a way to carve out time to learn the things of the Christian-Lutheran faith. 
