## SO JUST WHAT IS A TOTAL ECLIPSE?

A total solar eclipse happens when the moon's shadow passes over the earth so that the sun's light is blocked.

During a total eclipse the sky becomes dark (but not like midnight darkness). There might be a bit of a red glow to the sky that day. Brighter stars and planets might be visible.

And what is really cool is the glow of the outermost part of the sun. This is called the <u>Corona</u>. There is also a thing called <u>Prominences</u>... these are red loops that seem to almost flare out.
