Dear Confirmands and Parents,

We only have a few things left and Confirmation Sunday is just around the corner!

- <u>Sunday, May 19th</u>— I will be conducting final reviews / interviews during the Sunday School hour with students who did not attend camp pioneer or for those who didn't make prior arrangements with me.
- <u>Sunday, May 26th</u>— I will finish final reviews / interviews with those haven't completed and I will plan to hold a rehearsal that morning as well.
- <u>Sunday June 2nd</u>— Confirmands are asked to arrive by 750am. I will have a quick rehearsal with them. The Rite of Confirmation will take place during the 830am service. Just a few notes regarding the service:
  - Confirmands will process down the aisle and sit together.
  - following the offering Confirmands and their families will be invited forward to the front of the church (by the altar) where they will receive their confirmation Bible verse, a stole, and a special blessings. During the blessings parents and other family members will gather around the confirmand at the positioned kneeler having an opportunity to participate in that special blessing.

- After each confirmand has been confirmed, the service will continue with Holy Communion. The class expressed a desire to commune together so they will come forward and commune first as a group before the rest of the congregation.
- Following the final hymn, confirmands will recess down the aisle to the back of the church Allowing members to congratulate them.
- -Once the greeting is complete Confirmands will be asked to return to the front of the Church for a group photo. **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE UNTIL THIS PICTURE IS TAKEN!**

Confirmands will wear robes that morning, but please dress nicely and wear appropriate footwear. There is no formal "dress code" but it is a milestone in your faith lives and we hope that your attire will be fitting for the occasion (ex. no shorts, flip-flops, graphic t-shirts etc.).

I wish to thank all of you for your participation and patience this year. We had to make some changes but we made it through. As I often tell the kids, confirmation is not an end or equated to graduation; instead, it is a new beginning! I hope to continue to grow in faith with ALL of you. I know how demanding life and schedules can be, but I certainly hope that faith nurture and participation in the life and ministry of St. John's can find a primary spot in your lives.
