2025 Lutheran Church Extension Society Grant Application Summary St. John's Lutheran Church, Depew - Stephen Ministry Program



Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God. 2 Corinthians 1: 3-4

St. John's Leadership identified a need in our congregation of Christ-centered care services for grief, health issues, terminal illness or end of life, shut-ins or those in assisted living or nursing homes, financial difficulties, separation or divorce, parents of and/or children leaving home for college or military service, preparing for retirement, and as primary caregivers for loved ones. A Lutheran Church Extension Society (LCES) Grant Application was submitted to pursue Stephen Ministry as a new church ministry to meet the spiritual and emotional needs of our members. The 2025 LCES Grant awards are anticipated to be announced in June 2025.

Major Objectives

The primary objective of this new Christ-centered ministry is to meet the spiritual or emotional needs of congregational members. The secondary objective includes providing an opportunity for members to serve God through assisting others with spiritual and emotional needs. Our Stephen Ministers and Stephen Ministry Leaders would work closely with our Pastor and other member churches as an extension of pastoral care to see that the needs of congregational members are being met and provide regular Christ-centered care and support for as long as the person needs it.

Anticipated 2025 Goals and Activities

Goal 1 - To identify and provide training to two (2) congregational members as Stephen Ministry Leaders by early-Fall 2025.

Goal 2 – To have our Stephen Ministry Leaders train three (3) to five (5) congregational members to be Stephen Ministers before the end of 2025.

We anticipate holding a meeting in early June for anyone interested in learning more about the Stephen Ministry Program if the LCES Grant is awarded to St. John's.


