"IF YOU ABIDE IN MY WORD, YOU ARE TRULY MY DISCIPLES, AND YOU WILL KNOW THE TRUTH, AND THE TRUTH WILL SET YOU FREE." JOHN 8

December 10- Jeremiah 23:1-6

God will not let anything get in the way of his plan! The decedents of Abraham will be a blessing to the earth! December 13- Isaiah 53

December 15- Romans 5:12-17

Jesus the obedient son of God was born, suffered, died and rose for us! Through him the course of humanity has changed... "We are a new creation" (2 Cor 5:17). December 16-Hebrews 1:1-4
